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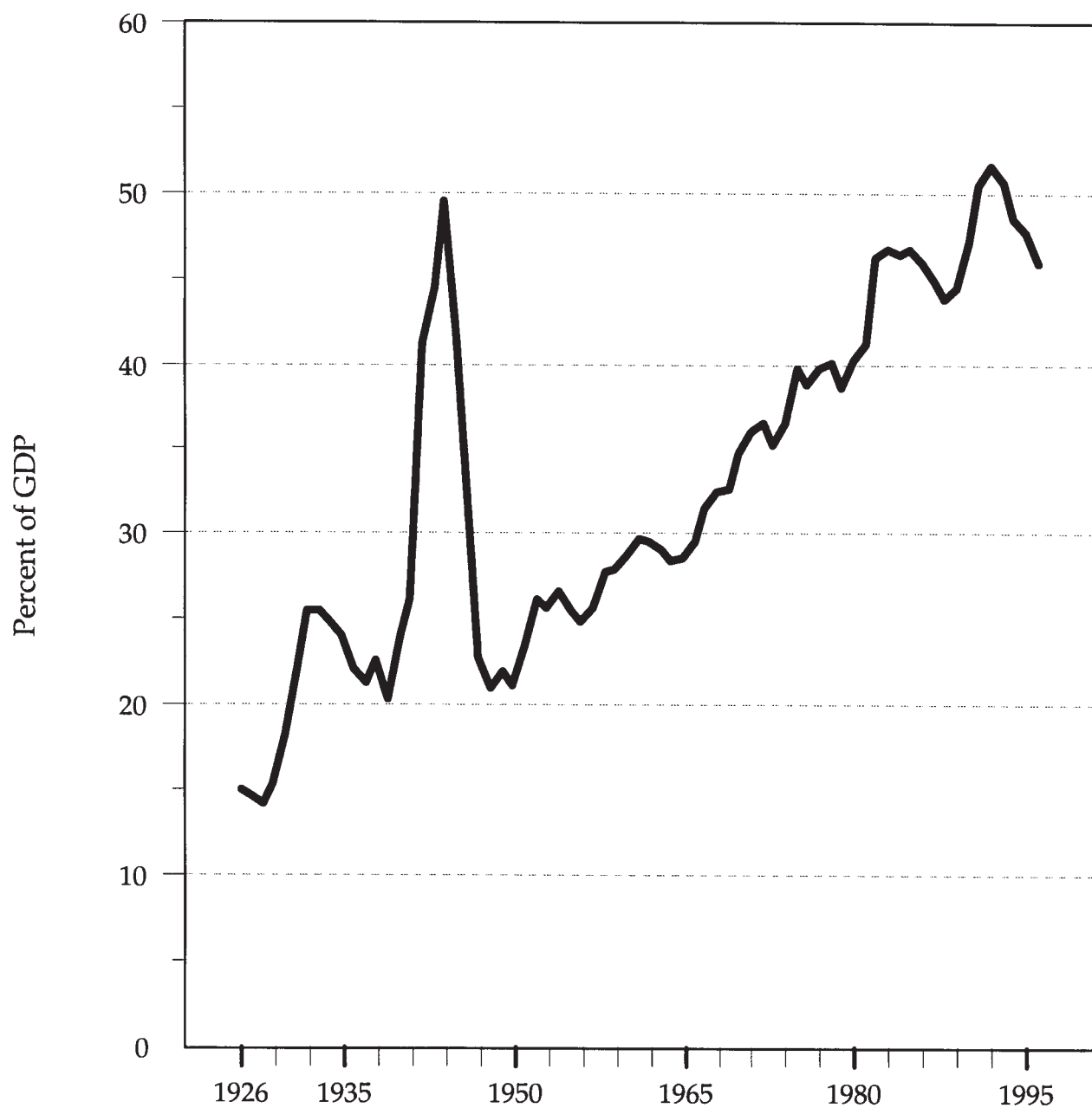
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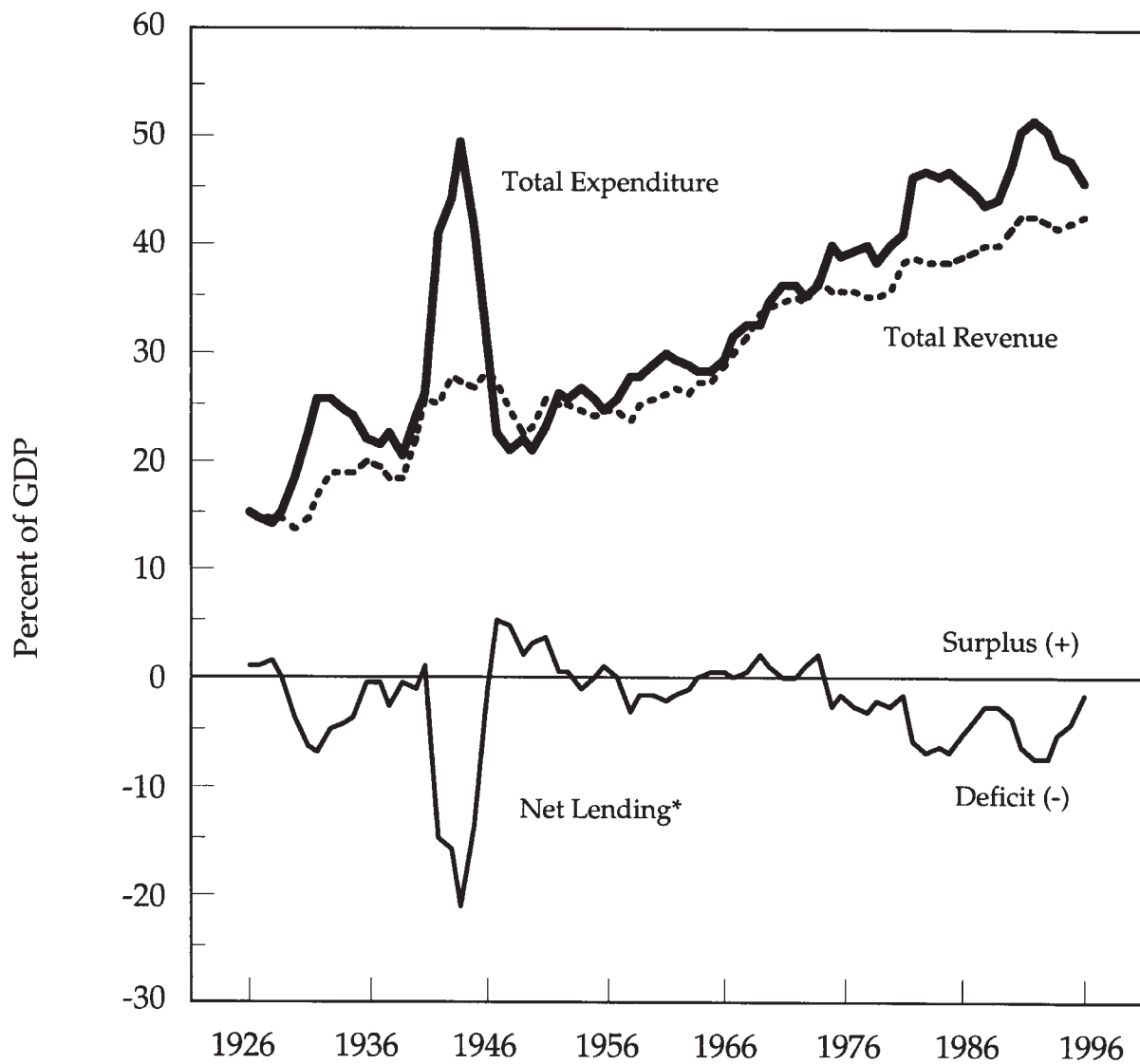
Figure 21: Local Transfer Payments, 1926 to 1995, as a Percent of GDP

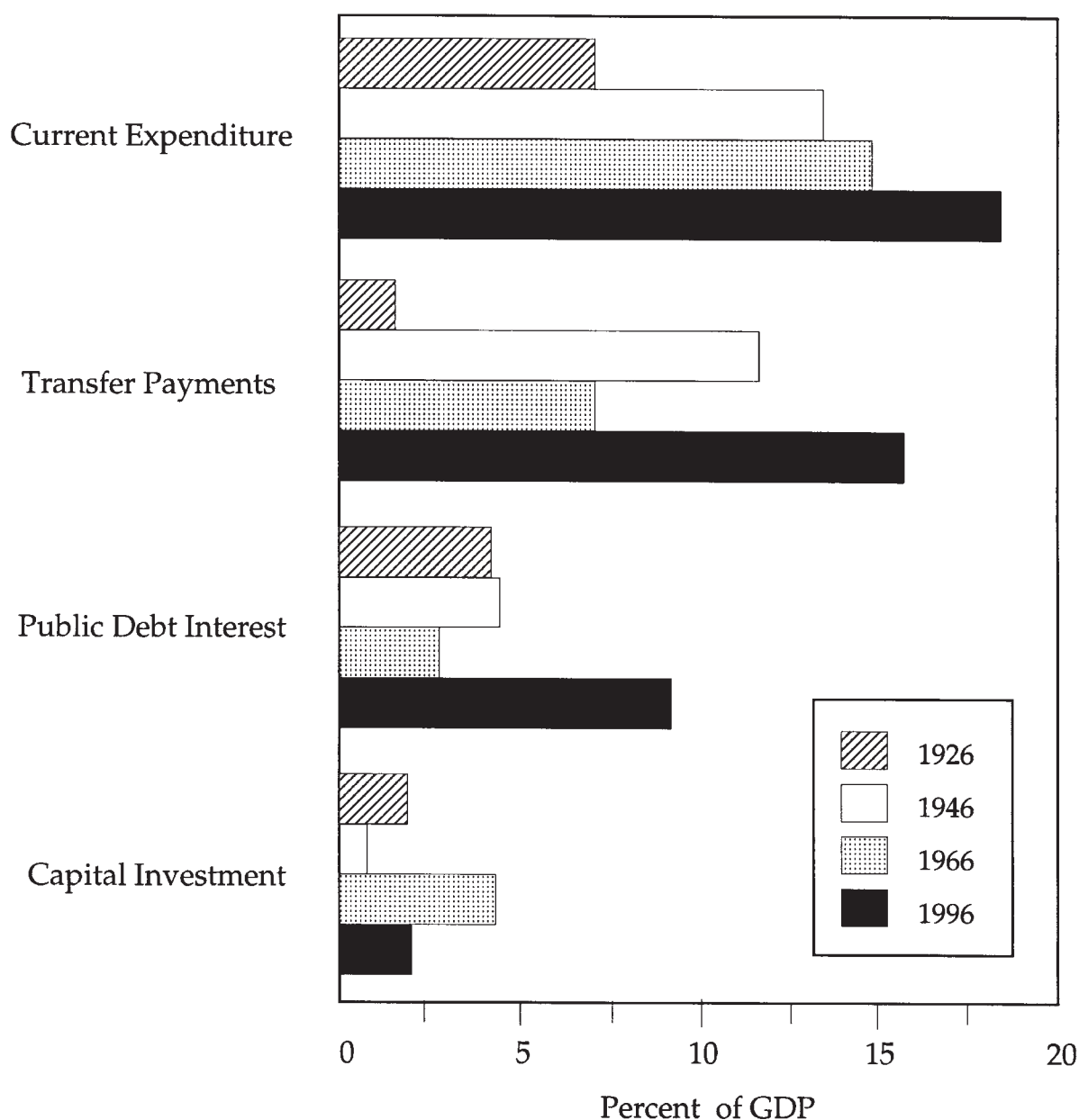
**Figure 2: Government Revenues, Expenditures,

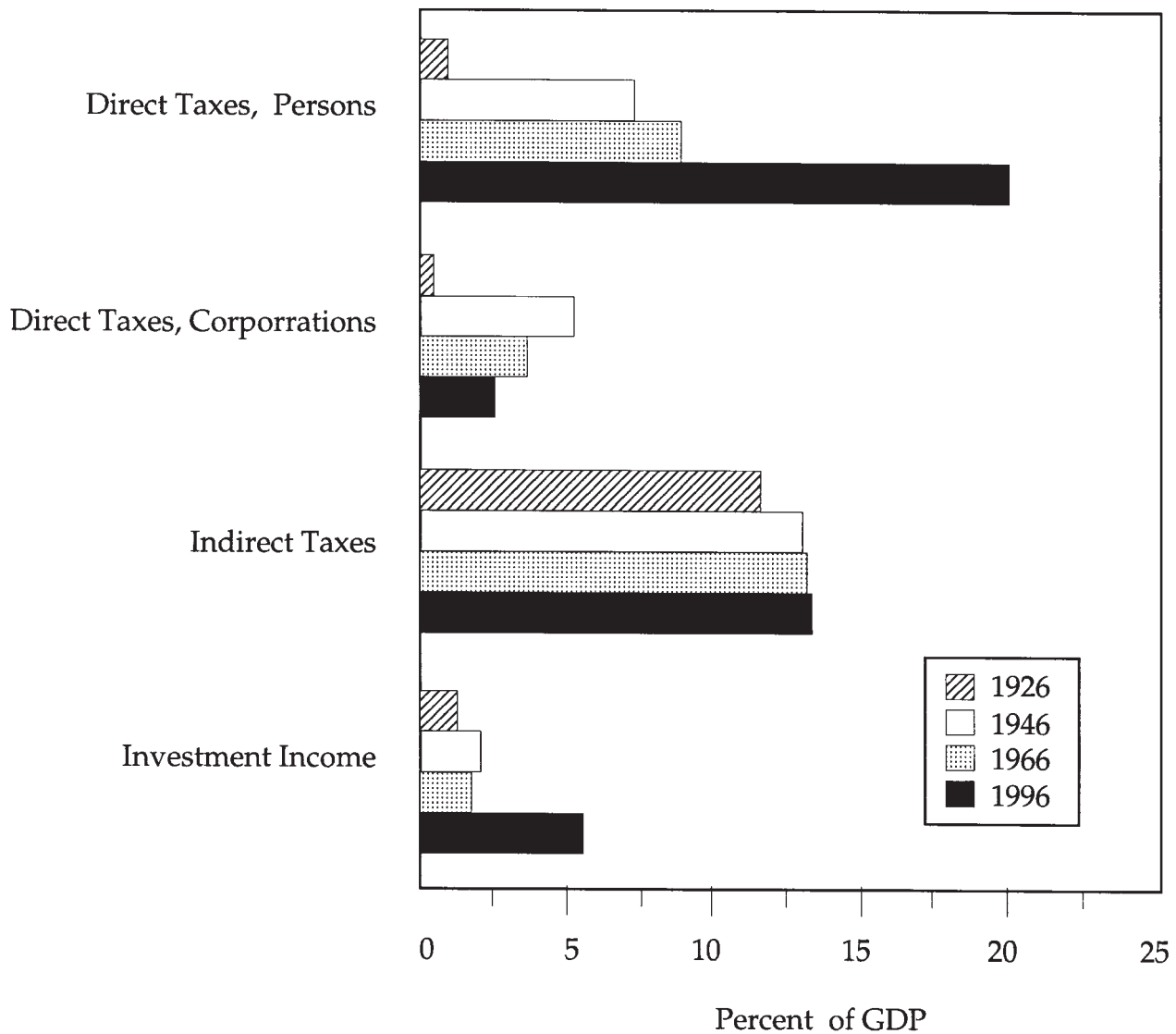

(% of GDP)**



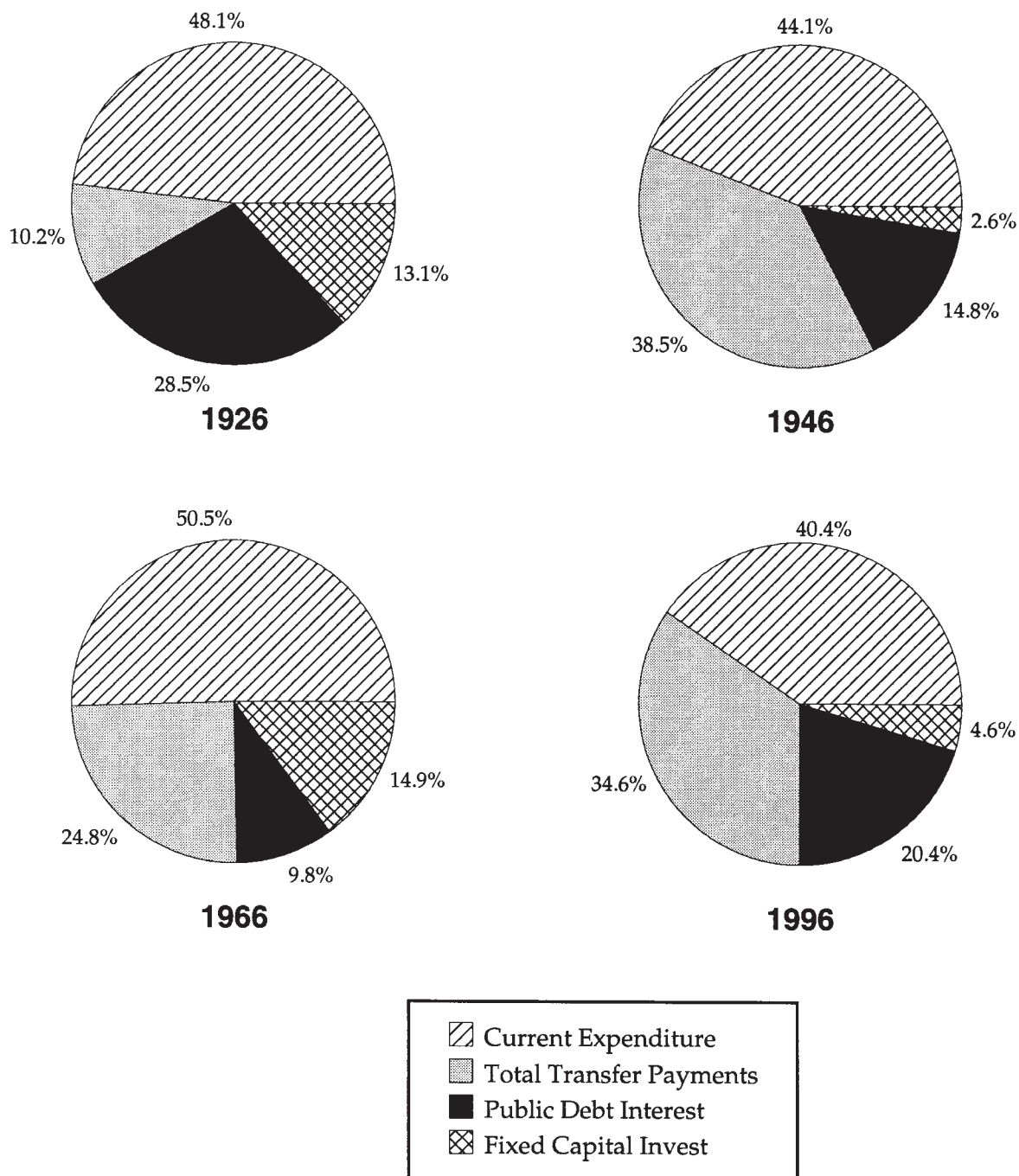

(% of GDP)**



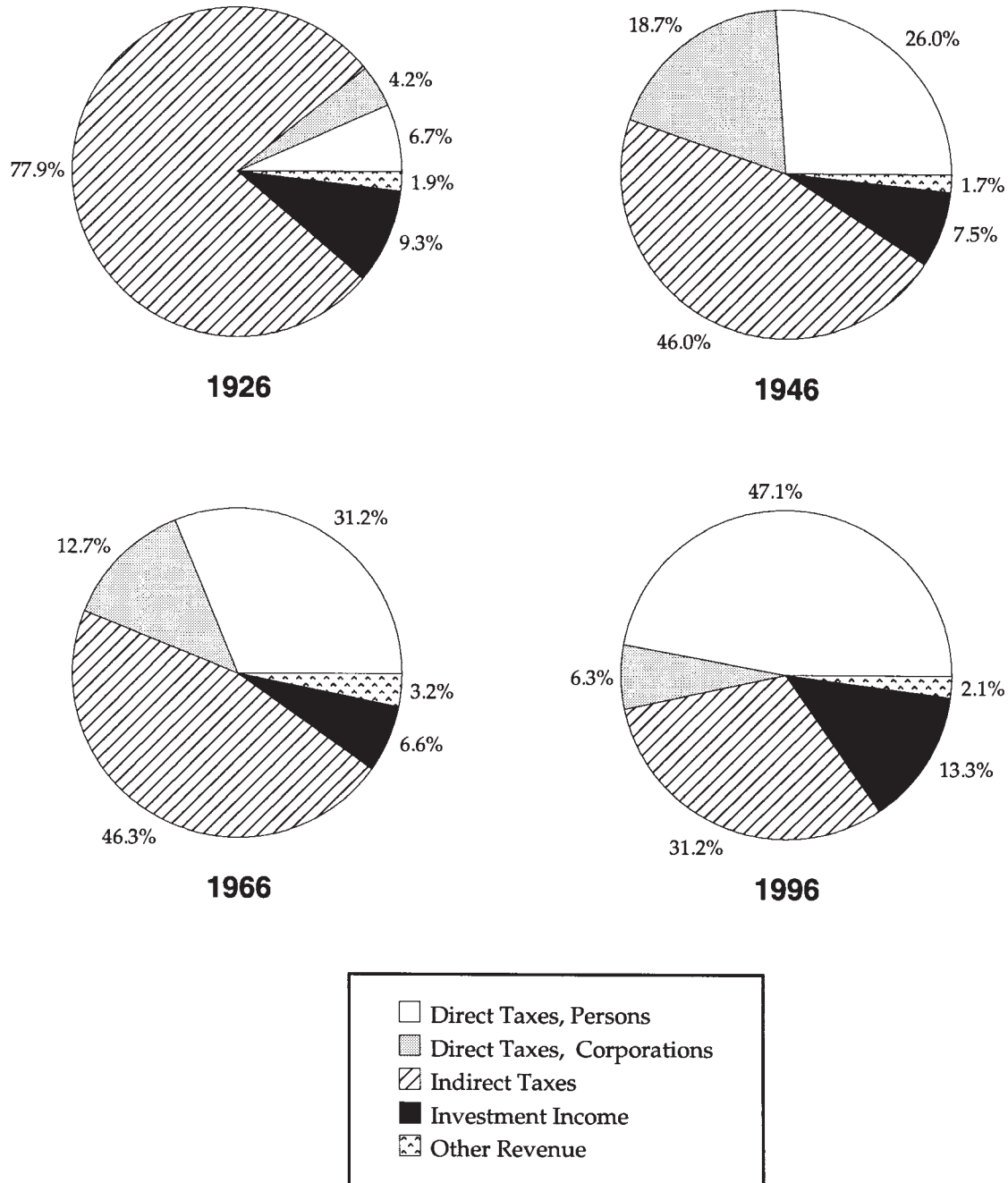

(Share of Total)**



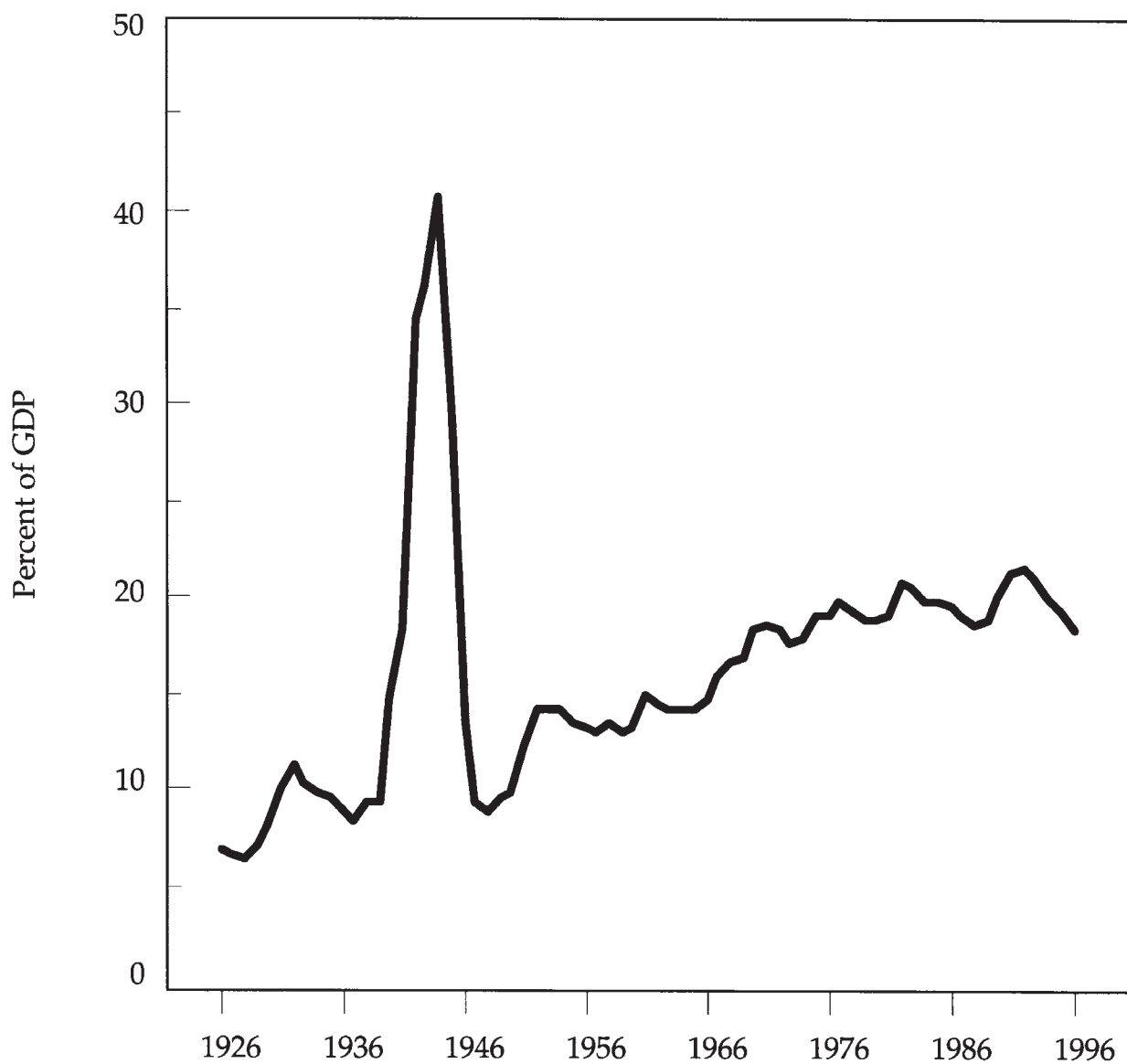

(Share of Total)**



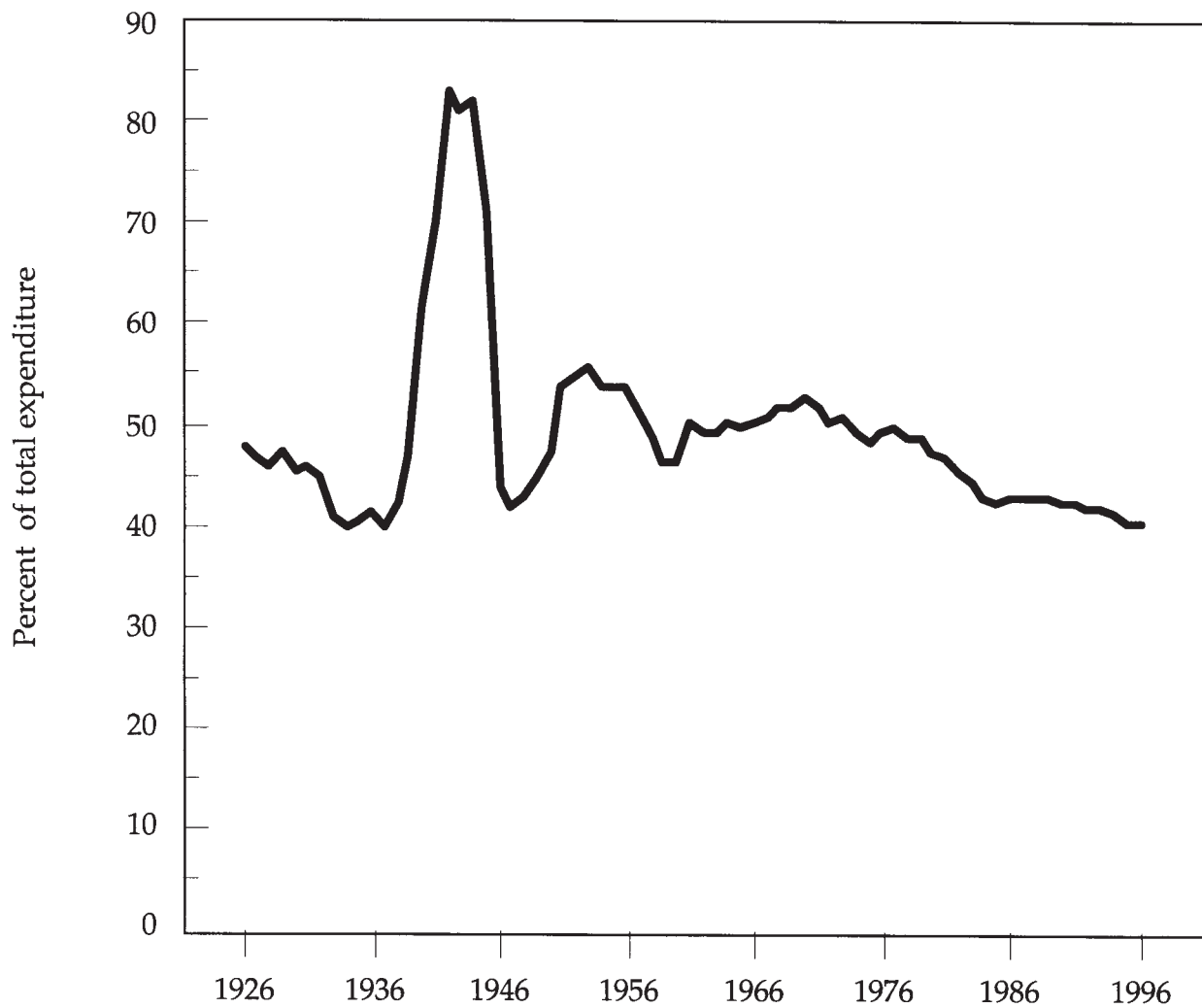

Figure 7: Government Current Expenditure on Goods and Services



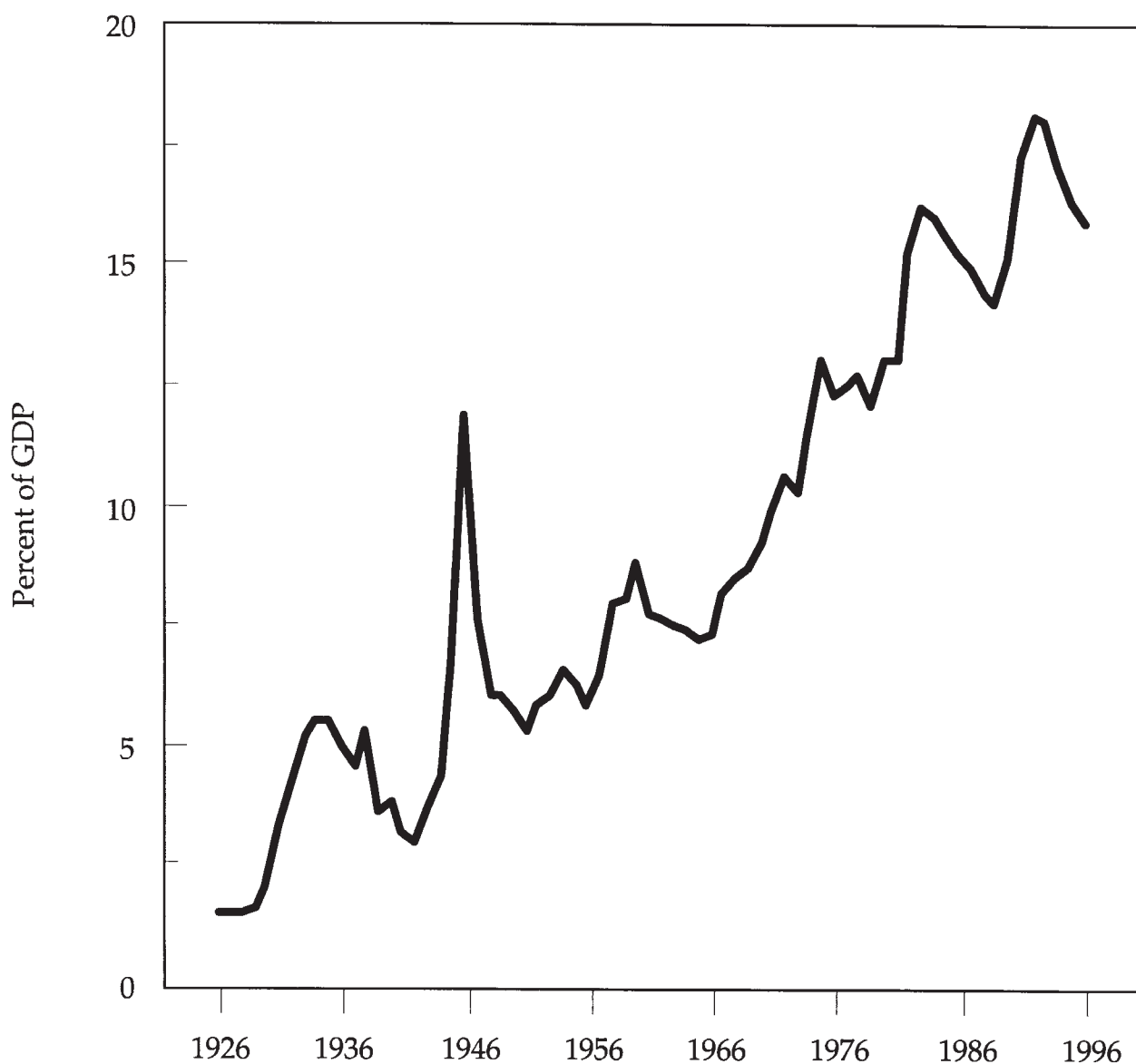

(Percent of Total Expenditure)**



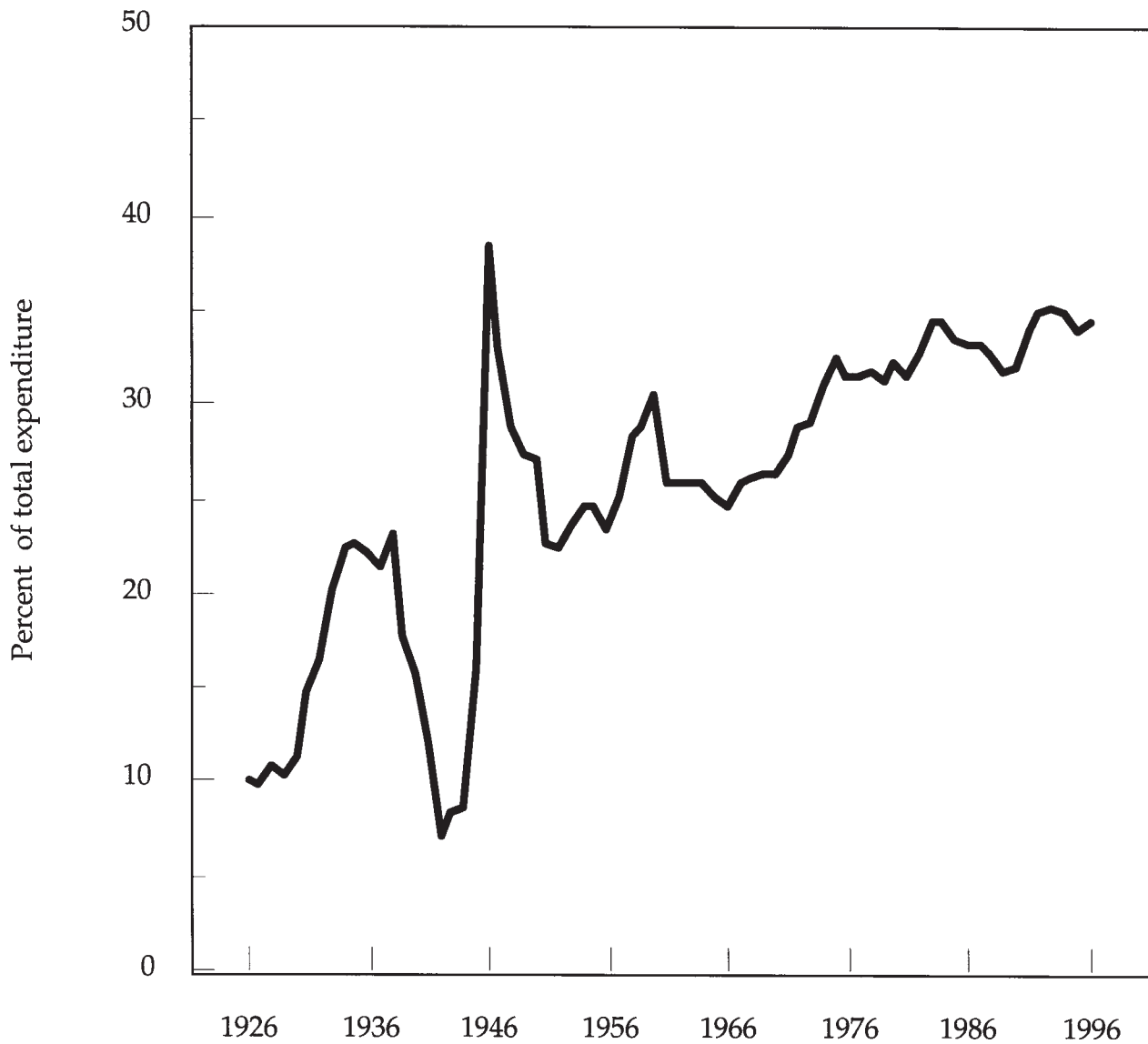

1926 to 1996, as a Percent of GDP**



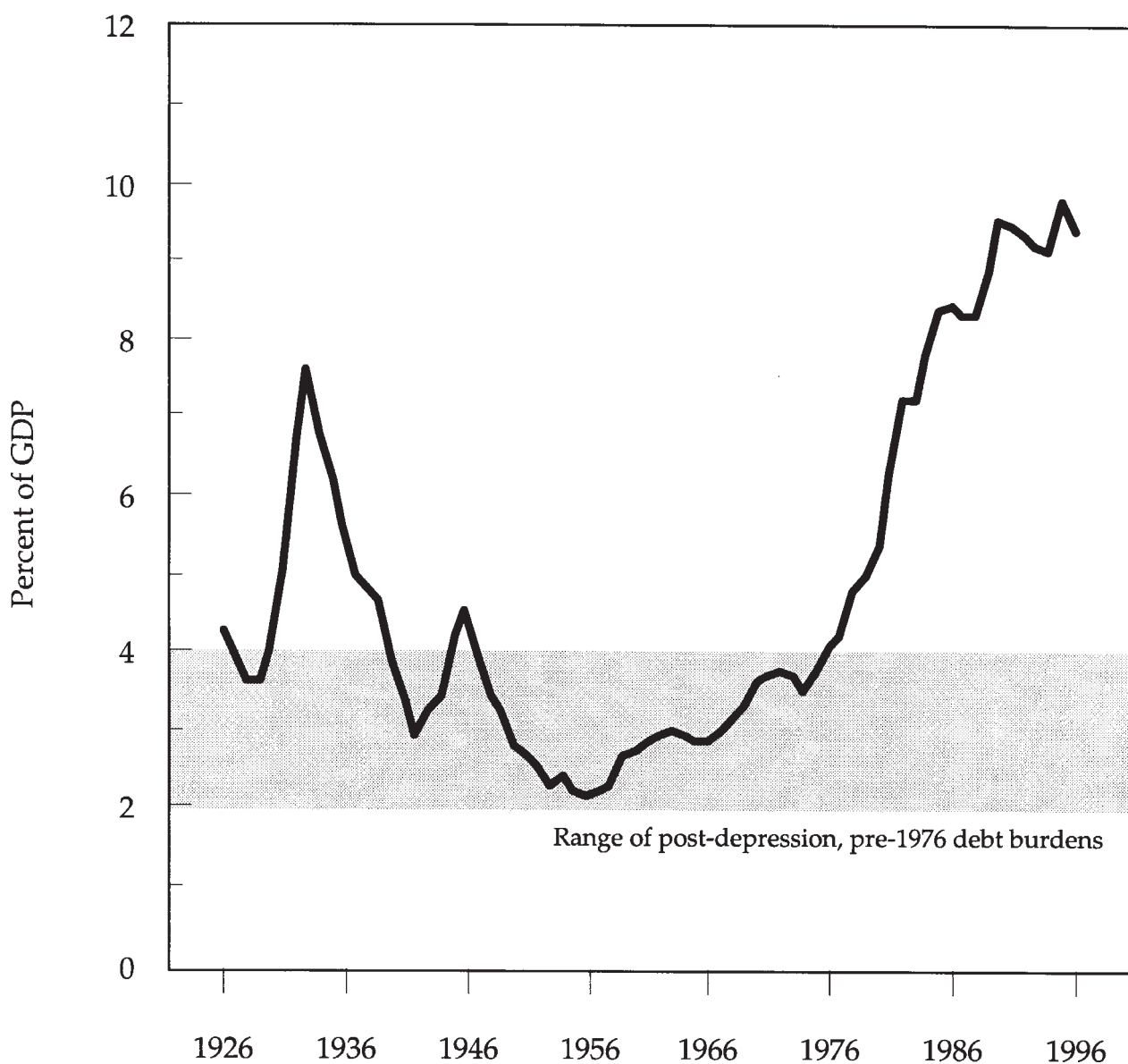

1926 to 1996, as a Percent of Total Expenditure**



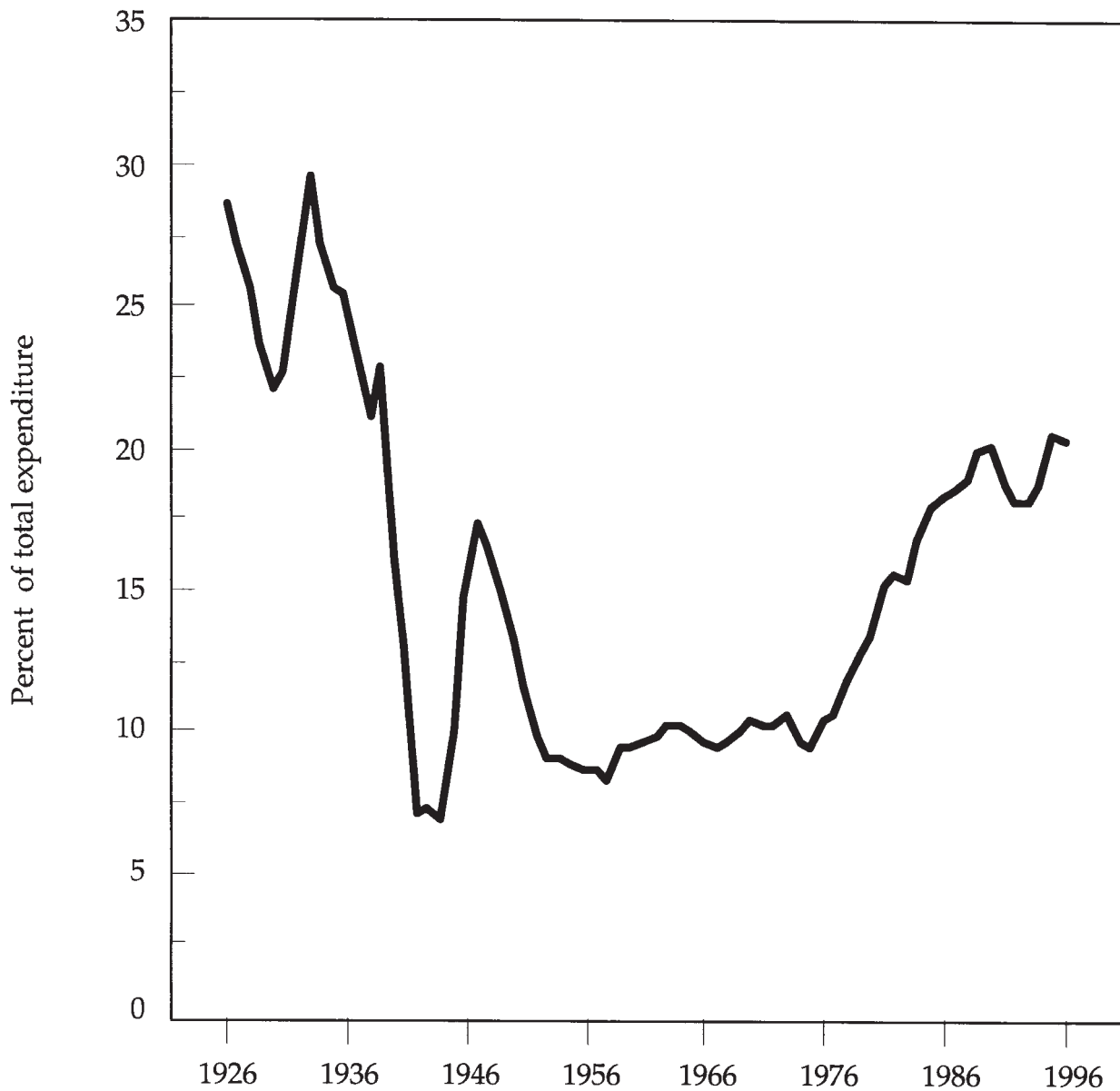

1926 to 1996, as a Percent of GDP**



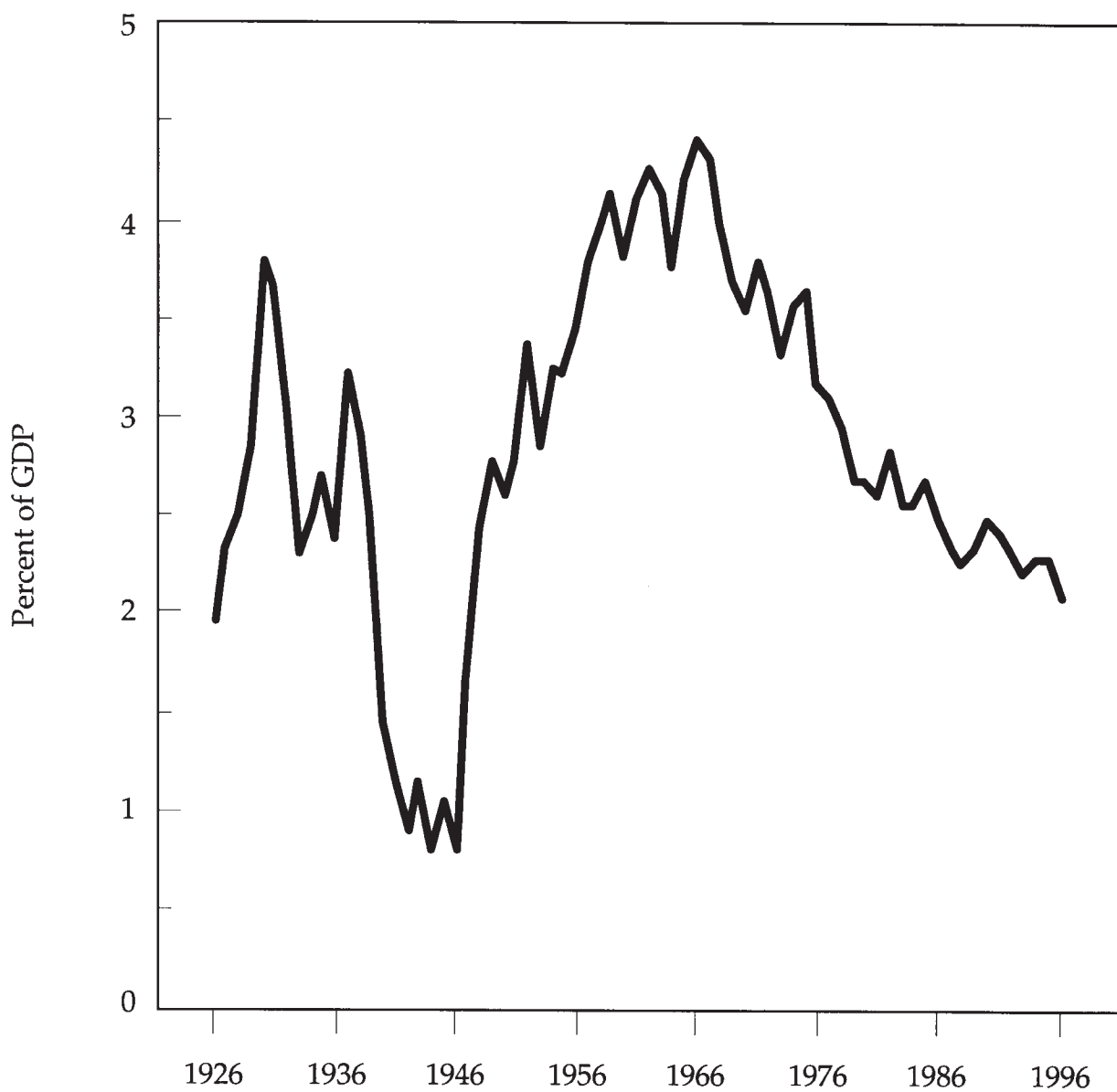

1926 to 1996, as a Percent of Total Expenditure**



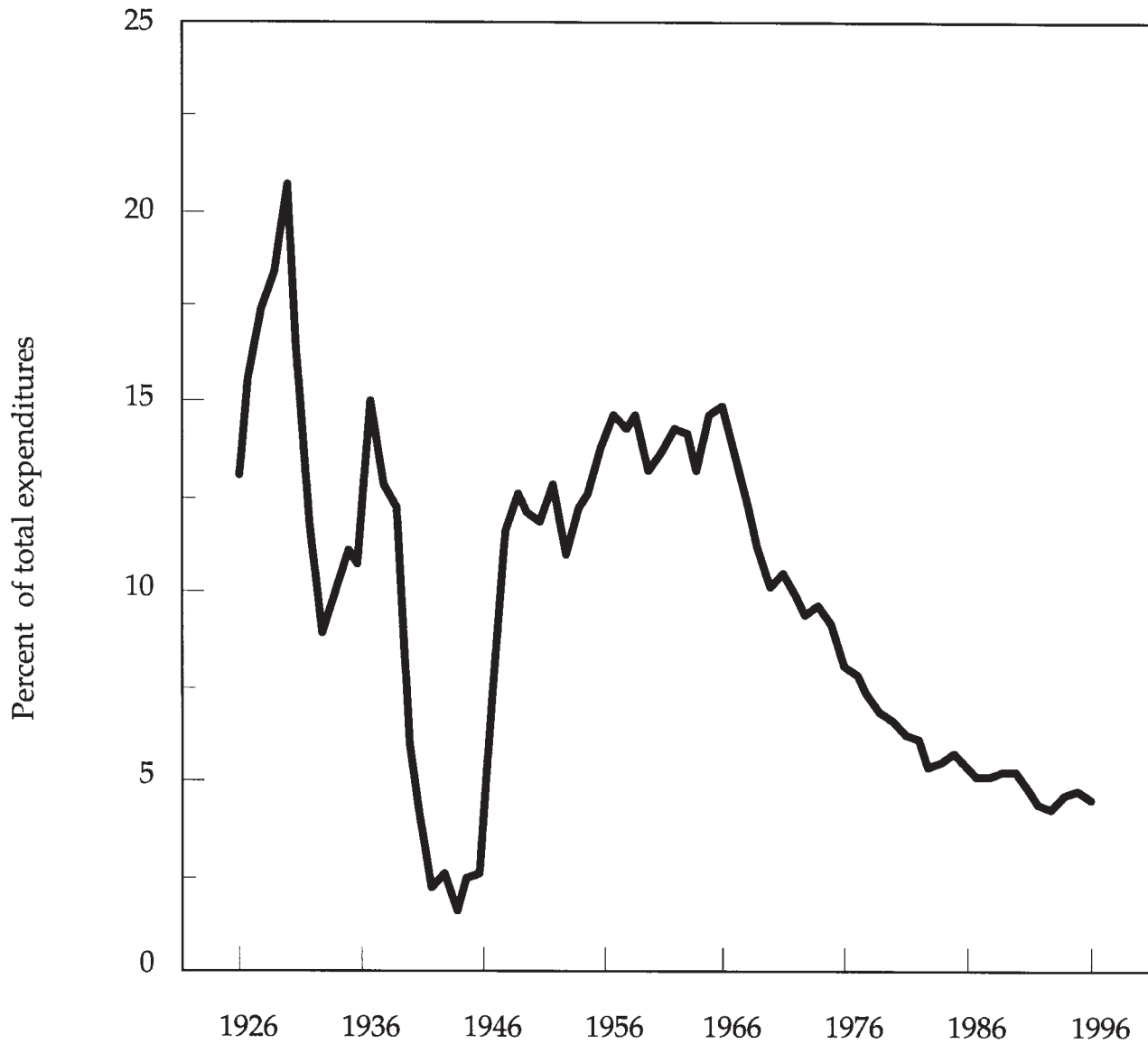

1926 to 1996, as a Percent of GDP**



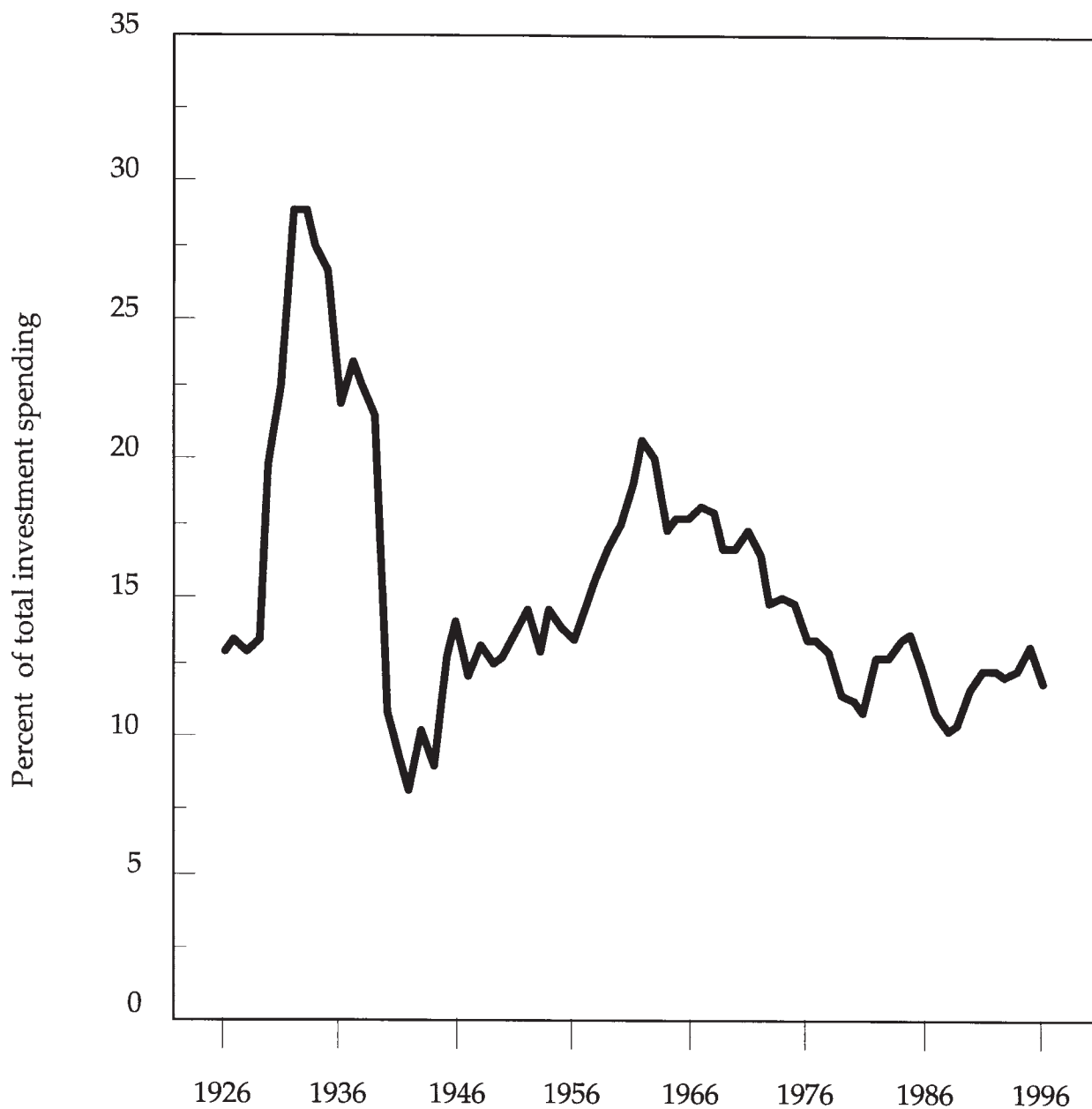

1926 to 1996, as a Percent of Total Expenditures**



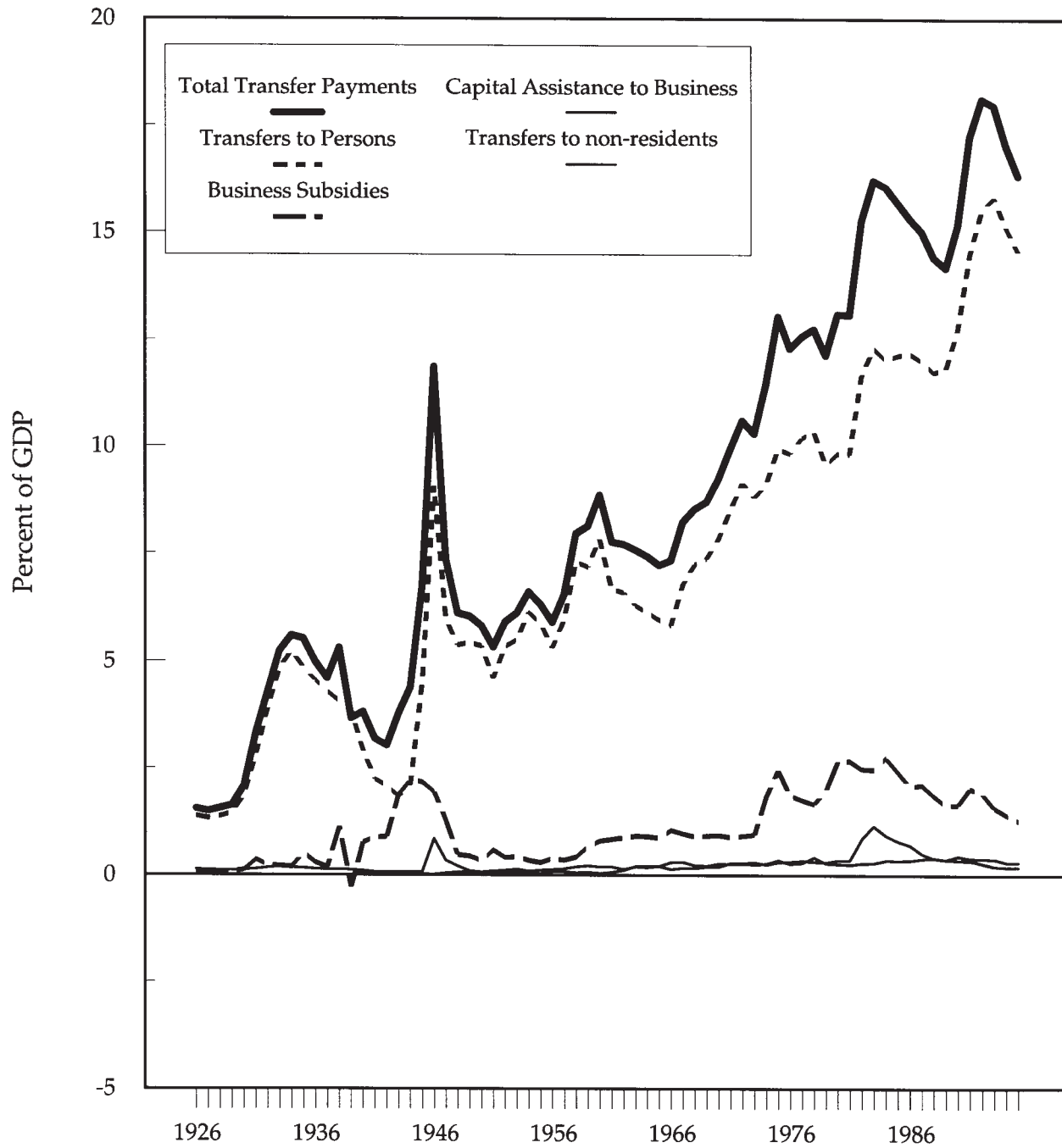

1926 to 1996, as a Percent of Total Investment Spending**



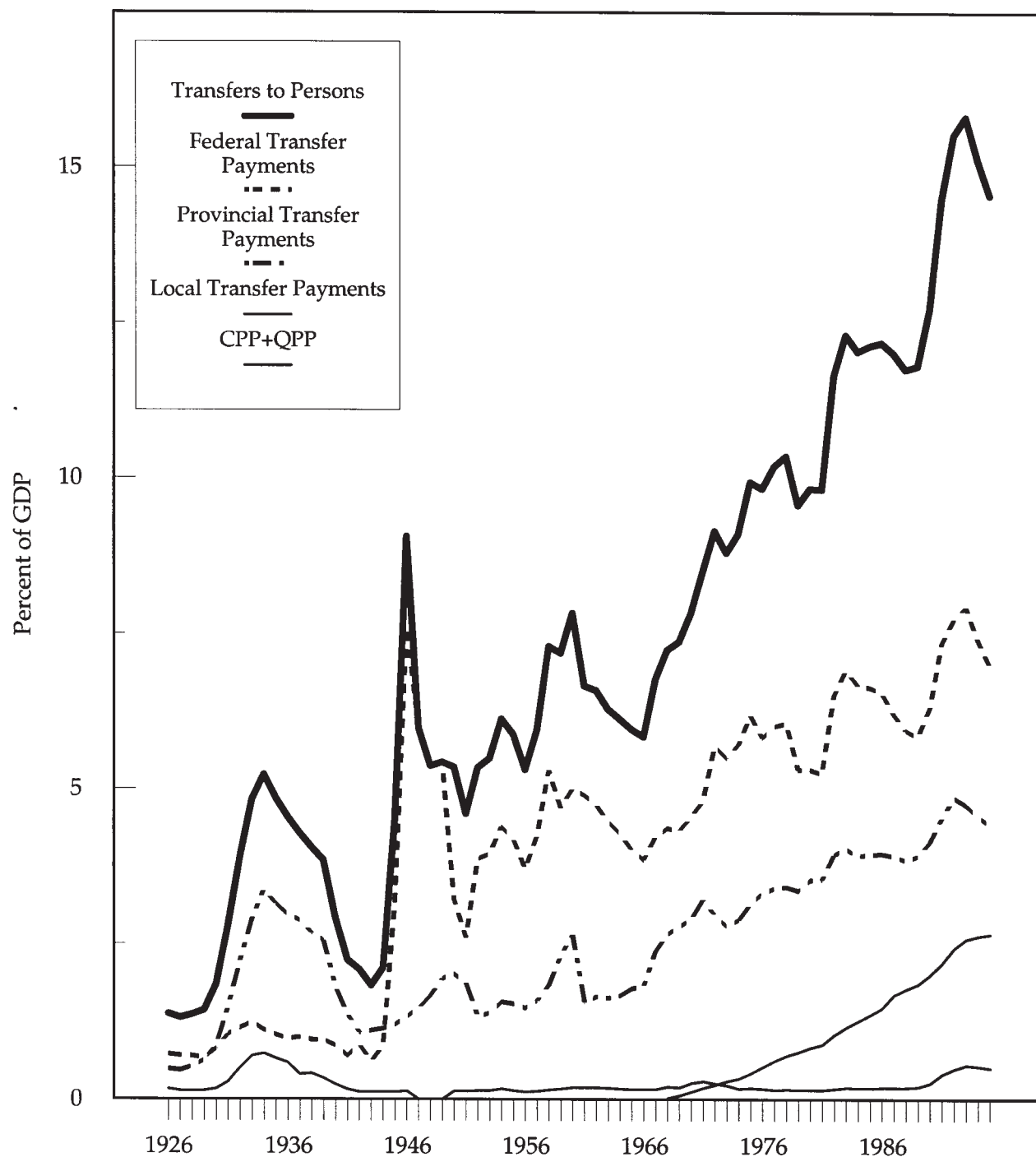

Figure 16: Government Transfer Payments to Various Groups, 1926 to 1995, as a Percent of GDP



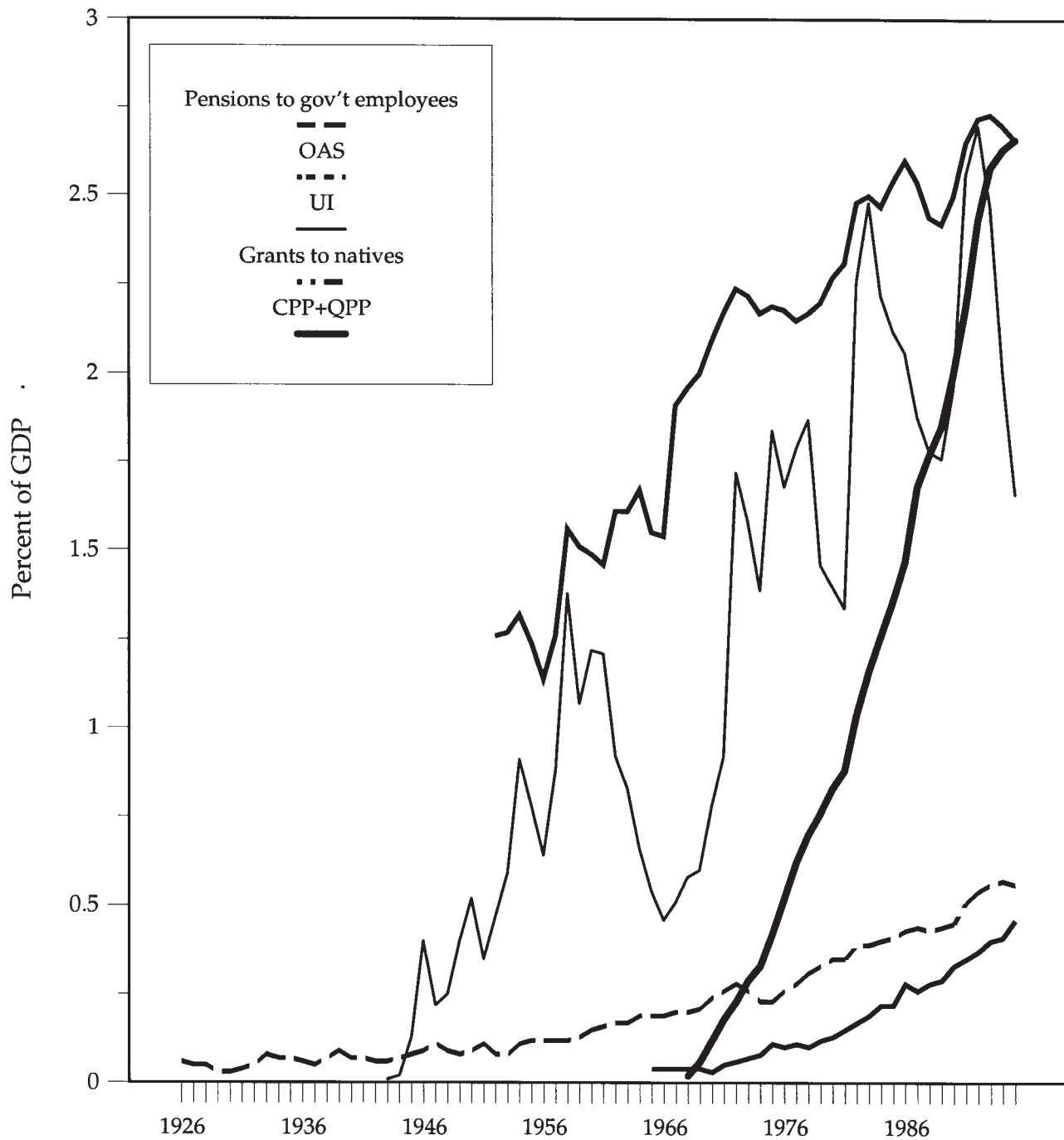

1926 to 1995, as a Percent of GDP**



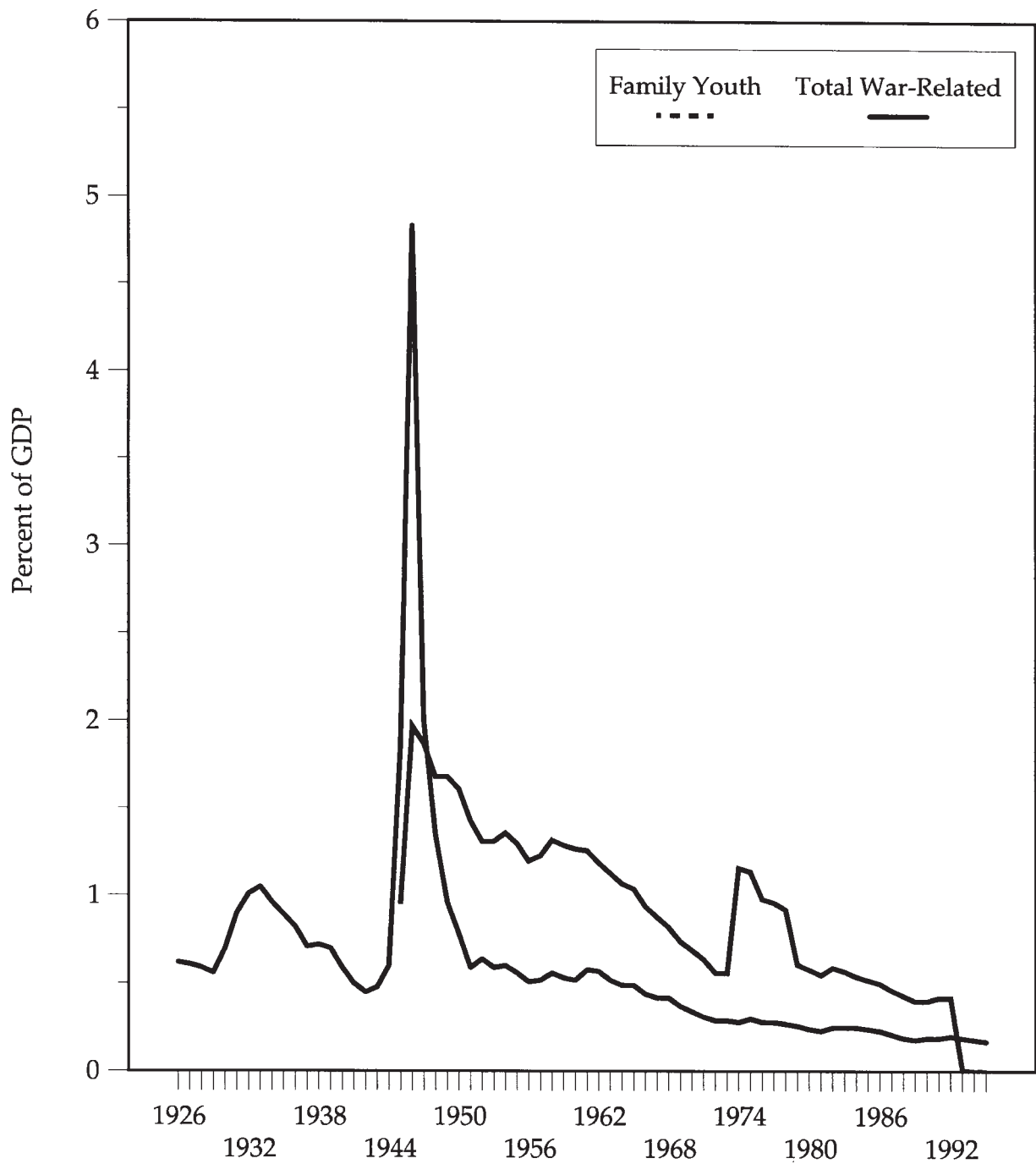

Figure 18: Increasing Federal Transfer Payments to Persons, 1926 to 1995, as a Percent of GDP



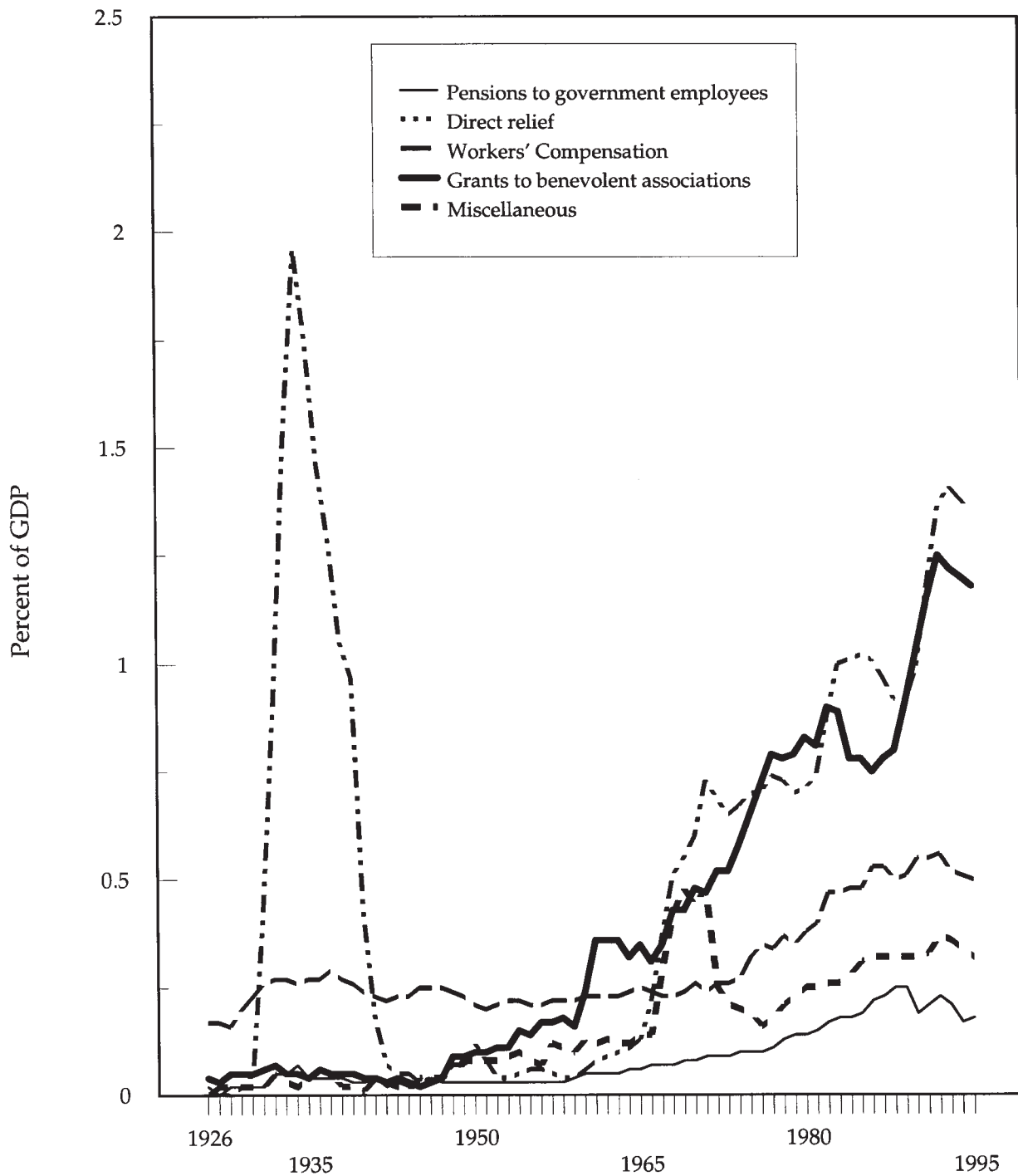

Figure 19: Declining Federal Transfer Payments to Persons, 1926 to 1995, as a Percent of GDP

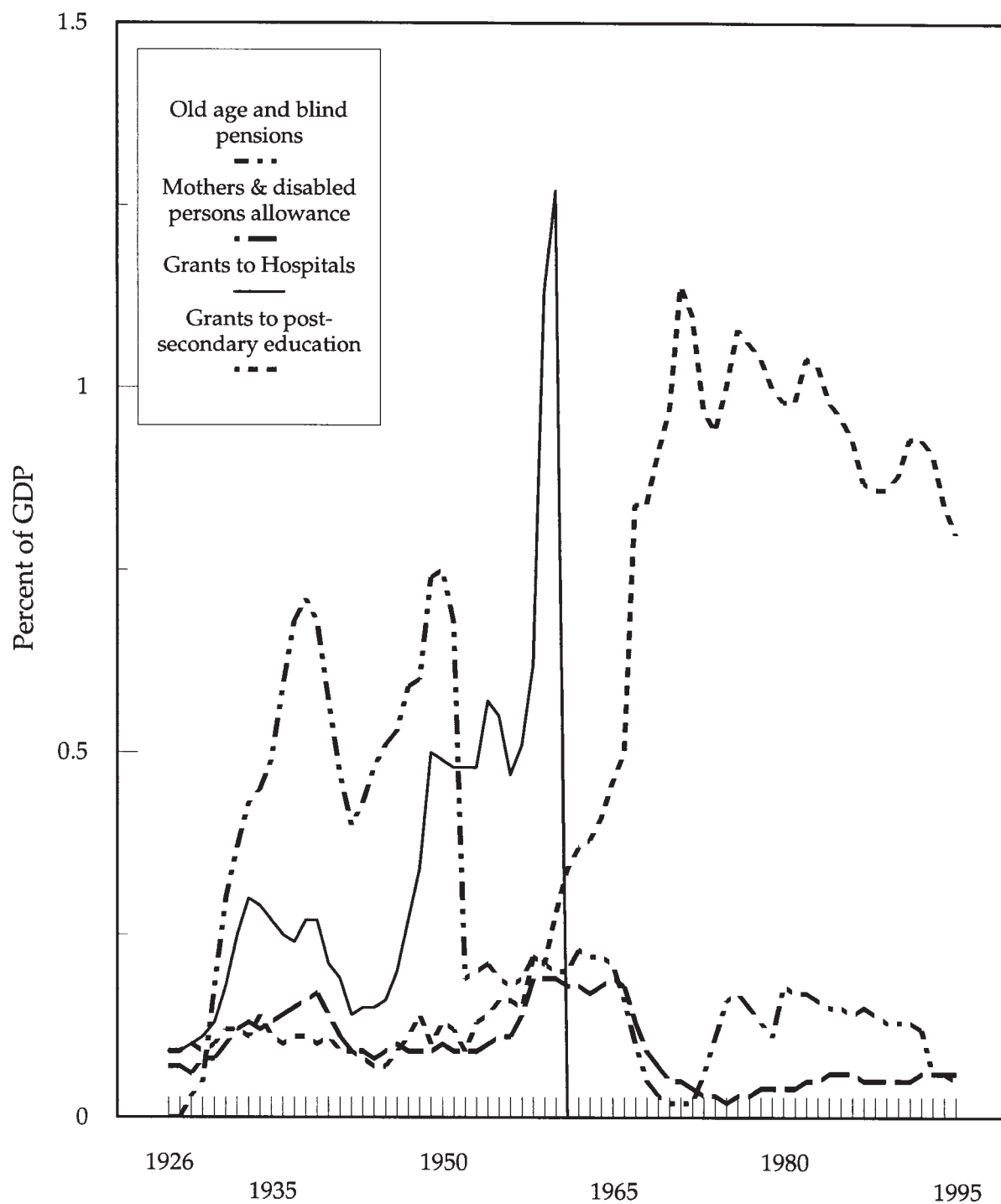

1926 to 1995**

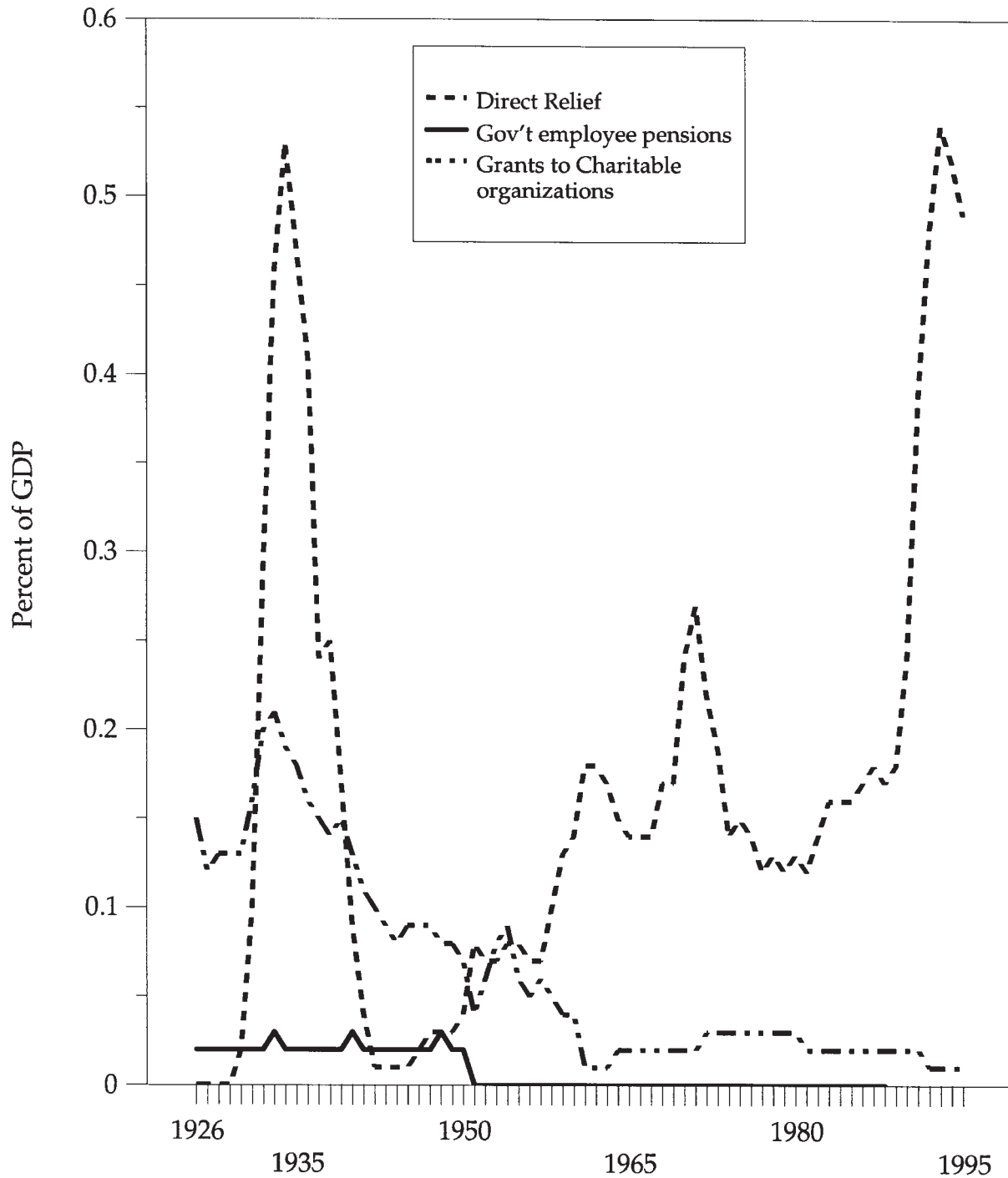
